

Little Birch & Aconbury's Joint Neighbourhood Development Plan

At the next meeting of the Steering Group, the Consultant Dr. David Nicholson, will be explaining the **Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan** he will have produced, following the discussion about David's 'Housing Delivery Report' at the last meeting in April.

The work is still currently under way by David and will show how the two parishes can meet Herefordshire Council's requirement for additional homes.

However the Draft Plan is much more than just how to meet housing targets. There will be many environmental issues such as the ones raised in the Questionnaires that were returned at the end of 2016. These reflect the kind of 'Neighbourhood' we would all like to see in the future. When completed, the **Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan** will be delivered to all households in Aconbury and Little Birch for consultation.

Anyone is welcome to attend these meetings and there is no long term commitment to be part of the Steering Group, so if you wish to be part of the decision process, remember that the next meeting at Little Birch Village Hall is on Wednesday 26 July at 7pm. At that meeting the Steering Group will be discussing the Draft Plan, and those present will be able to suggest any amendments.
