General Policing Rural

In **May** there were **122** incidents reported to the police for the South Hereford Rural Area which were either, attended and dealt with by us, or response officers. **13** of these were “Grade 1”, which means 999 emergency calls which is either life threatening or a crime in progress. There were **21** crimes. These are broken down in to; **7** Theft, **3** Assault, **6** Misc, **2** Damage and **3** Burglary.

Incidents of note

We have sadly been hit with a few Burglaries again. If you would like one of the team to come and provide a security assessment please email and we will arrange to come and see you, Both Business and Residential. We now have a dedicated Business and Cyber crime department who offer Crime prevention advice too along with cyber security and home security advice and help.

If you have any information regarding any of the above you can contact Hereford Police on 101, in an emergency please dial 999. Please be aware that any information provided within this letter is to inform you of incidents of note and to request possible assistance. We do not want to worry you in anyway. Any incidents stated are infrequent and spread about a wide area. Herefordshire is a safe place to live!
